THERE ARE TOTAL 36 PADAV STHAL IN THE PARIKRAMA ROUTE - 28 COME UNDER UTTAR PRADESH.

THE AVERAGE DISTANCE BETWEEN EACH PADAV STHAL IS APPROX. 20KM. THE PILGRIMS AND DEVOTEES STOP HERE FOR REST, FOOD AND AMENITIES AS WELL AS NIGHT STAY.


















BRAJ 84 KOS PARIKRAMA ROUTE MAP & TOPOGRAPHY








EXISTING & PROPOSED CROSS-SECTIONS OF NH THROUGH PARIKRAMA ROUTE











Proposed Layout Plan Of Musical Fountain at Kusum Sarover




VRINDAVAN - SNAPSHOT (PROPOSED STRUCTURE PLAN)













